

BONVUE WATER & SANITATION DISTRICT
749th MEETING January 10, 2023

Ed Zimbleman called the 749th meeting of the Bonvue Water & Sanitation District to order at 6:04 pm at the West Metro Fire Station at 1st and Garrison. Board members present were: Cathy Kentner, Kim Cooley, and Ed Zimbleman. Casey Beckett was absent.

Old Business:

We may need to look for a leak detection company. From the system totals it appears we have a leak. Or it could be the new sidewalk people using our fire hydrant. Sidewalk project said they only used a couple thousand gallons. Sewer jetting company probably used most of the extra, System totals are back down this month but still show a loss. We will see what next month shows.

Will with Semocor said that the Backflow program should be completed by 5-12-22. In the works. Short staffed so they will get to it when they are able.

Ed met with Denver Water. They are planning on replacing our master meter soon. Water will need to be turned off for at least 8 hours. No time frame yet. Ed is also meeting with Green Mountain Water to set up a connection so we can hook up to their system to have working hydrants during that time. Still in the works. No new update.

Meter replacements have started. They have been programmed by Dana Kepner. Coffee shop meter was replaced. Need to get a company in for their other meter and the one at the Credit Union. Ed spoke to someone recommended by Semecor (Mac) and he came out to locate the shut off for the meter that still needs to be replaced. Credit Union meter was under water. Water was pumped out. Mac will do the repair and replace both the second coffee shop meter and the Credit Union meter.

Lead pipe form must be submitted by October 2024

DRC Construction completed the cleaning and scope of the sewer system. Camera work was emailed to board members. They still need to send estimates, etc. There is a collapsed line on Garland near the church. That is the one that must be taken care of immediately.

Cathy talked to the lawyer. Dola now says they won't contest our ability to call and hold the election and whoever is elected this May will be considered a valid board going forward.

New Business:

Cathy made a motion calling for adoption of Resolution 2023-1, A RESOLUTION CALLING FOR THE 2023 REGULAR DISTRICT ELECTION AND APPOINTING A DEIGNATED ELECTION OFFICIAL. Kim seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
